<p>Let’s read for meaning!</p> <p><b>Have someone read a book to you. Draw a picture of the main character and setting and your favorite part. Tell why.</b></p> <p>K.RL.5.1</p>	<p>Let’s write and draw!</p> <p><b>Draw a picture and/or write about what you did today. Tell two to three details about your day.</b></p> <p>K.W.3.1</p>	<p>Let’s write an informational book!</p> <p><b>Draw and/or write about a topic that you know about. Include as much information as you know about your topic. Also include pictures/illustrations that you can label.</b></p> <p>K.W.2.1</p>
