Skill: Recognize place value through thousands quickly

Players: 2

Materials: 3 dice per player (or one row of dice pictured below per player)

Procedure:

1) All players roll their dice at the same time. (If you do not have dice at home, you can cut out the cards below, place them in a cup, and pull three cards out of the cup.)

Example: You roll

2) Players then arrange their dice to make the largest three-digit number possible.

Example: Arrange die from greatest to least to make the largest possible number



3) The first player to finish calls "Rock N' Roll," and CORRECTLY verbalizes their number to the other player.

Example: Read your number by saying, "Five hundred thirty two."

- 4) The other player must place their numbers in the correct order even if they were not the first to call "Rock N' Roll."
- 5) If the first player done is also the player with the largest number, they earn 10 pts. If not, they only earn 5 pts. and the player with the highest number also earns 5 pts.
- 6) The first player to 50 pts. is the winner.

Game Pieces:

One row (6 pieces) per player or 3 dice per player
