Skill: Recognize place value through thousands quickly

Players: 2


Materials: 3 dice per player (or one row of dice pictured below per player)

Procedure:

1) All players roll their dice at the same time. (*If you do not have dice at home, you can cut out the cards below, place them in a cup, and pull three cards out of the cup.*)

Example: You roll 

2) Players then arrange their dice to make the largest three-digit number possible.

Example: Arrange die from greatest to least to make the largest possible number 

3) The first player to finish calls “*Rock N’ Roll*,” and CORRECTLY verbalizes their number to the other player.

Example: Read your number by saying, “Five hundred thirty two.”

4) The other player must place their numbers in the correct order even if they were not the first to call “*Rock N’ Roll*.”

5) If the first player done is also the player with the largest number, they earn 10 pts. If not, they only earn 5 pts. and the player with the highest number also earns 5 pts.

6) The first player to 50 pts. is the winner.

Game Pieces:

One row (6 pieces) per player or 3 dice per player
