## Using Fractions to Make Wholes

## Number of Players: 2

## Materials:

- Game board
- Game cards
- Tokens
- 20 counters
(something small like pennies or buttons or legos)


## Directions:

1. Cut out game cards and tokens.
2. Find 20 small counters.
3. Arrange the cards in a mixed deck, face down.
4. Draw a card from the deck. Place a counter on the game board to show the fraction of the whole.
5. Take turns drawing cards and placing counters on the game board.
6. The player who places the final counter on a shape to make 1 whole wins the token for that shape.
7. Continue drawing cards until all shapes are covered.
8. The player with the most tokens at the end is the winner!
