<u>Level 1:</u> I am reading word-by-word. Sometimes I read 2 or 3 words together, but not often. I am not sure I understand what the author means. I am not reading like I talk. I read without expression.

<u>Level 2:</u> I read mostly in two-word phrases, and sometimes with three- or four-word phrases. Sometimes I read word-by-word. At times I do not understand what the author means. Sometimes I am not reading like I talk. I read some parts with expression.

<u>Level 3:</u> Most of the time I read in three- or four-word phrases. Mostly my reading sounds like I do when I talk. I read with expression most of the time. I understand what I am reading.

<u>Level 4:</u> I read in longer, meaningful phrases. I understand what I am reading. My reading sounds like I do when I talk. I use expression and am comfortable when I read out loud.
